- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them
 - Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- · Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
 - Never force your child to take part in sport
- · Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
 - Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
 - Publicly accept officials' judgements
 - Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport
 - · Use correct and proper language at all times
 - If you see examples of parents behaving poorly please report it to club officials."
